SCHILLERETTE took up a forward position after the start, patiently stalked the pacesetter from the three path for nearly a half, was asked for a response commencing to challenge for the lead coming into the stretch, closed in willingly, drew on dead even terms with the runner up with an eighth to go, went by a couple of jumps later and kicked clear, being kept to the task at hand. QUEENS OR BETTER carved the pace while saving ground, was let out in upper stretch, clung to a sliver of a lead approaching the furlong marker, surrendered to the top one soon afterwards, but held well for the place. DRINKSONTHEHOUSE came out last after lightly brushing the left side of the starting gate, went a few strides then greenly ducking inward several paths, was grabbed hold and put back on a truer course, left the backstretch from the three path, tipped a path wider at the head of the stretch, showed some late foot en route for the show. JULIANN'S APPROVAL three wide on the turn, tired. RENNINA saved ground and was no factor. FRESH BREWED gave chase from the outside and was through after completing a half. CITY VICE rank early, was steadied between rivals just before reaching the half mile pole, took the inside route around the turn, angled outward for the stretch run, but made no impact.
