### Footnotes

BAIT away in good order, assumed a forward position soon after the start, vied with WINNING CASE from the three path, went by, with the rider not needing to ask the mount for any speed, drew out to a commanding lead during the run through the furlong grounds, began to get noticeably leg weary a sixteenth down the road, held safely. ERIN ENCHANTED bumped lightly with SHESABRONXBOMBER after bobbling at the start, left the backstretch three wide, was asked for some run midway on the turn, ducked inward after overhauling EYES OF SUNSHINE in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths pole, cut the corner under much stronger handling, was taken back to the outside after settling into upper stretch, closed well for second, with the total margin gained deceptively increased by the weakening winner. SHESABRONXBOMBER bumped lightly with the runner up just out of the gate, took the overland route around the turn and displayed a good kick to grab third. SALLY'S DREAM four wide at the half mile pole, lacked the necessary stretch response. SUAVE N SASSY fractious behind the gate, unseated the rider, was apprehended quickly, was reluctant to load, broke awkwardly and spotted the field a lengthy head start, began to settle into proper stride soon after entering the bend, was placed in the five path at the head of the stretch, showed good interest improving position down the lane, receiving only occasional attention with the whip from the right side. BELLACOURT in hand after zig-zagging her way leaving the starting gate, failed to reach a contending position. HALL OF FLAME taken off heels as WINNING CASE crossed over to the inside, raced three wide on the turn, was put to a prolonged drive, and tired. EYES OF SUNSHINE saved ground, was urged on the turn, faltered. WINNING CASE under the whip leaving the gate, was placed in the two path, remained a pace factor for a half, then wilted. LA CHIQUILINA wheeled at the start, losing the rider as a result, There was a Stewards' Inquiry focusing on the start of the race before the result was declared official.
