HILLSWICK vied between rivals from the three path for a half mile, starting from the nine-sixteenths pole, left the five-sixteenths pole locked up in a one on one battle with the runner up, got leaned upon by that rival spinning into the lane, was herded outward by KHAN OF KHANS and brushed at several points as the pair battled for command down the stretch, put away the aforementioned foe for good with about a sixteenth to go and kicked clear. KHAN OF KHANS got off to a sharp start to grab the lead in a flash, settled into the two path, argued with at least two other opponents until the five-sixteenths pole, began to drift out turning for home, leaning on the top one, continued to make his way outward as he proceeded down the stretch, once again making light contact with and taking the eventual winner along for the ride, yielded at the sixteenth pole, but held well enough to secure second. COLJAK raced along the outside, proved no match for the top twosome. BERT B DON took the inside route tracking the ongoing pace dispute, came up empty for the stretch drive. PERCUSIONIST (ARG) strung out in the four path departing the backstretch, took over for AUGUST OSAGE to contest the pace outside the first two finishers, began to drop back late on the turn and steadily tired thereafter. AUGUST OSAGE three wide, disputed the pace between rivals until the seven-sixteenths pole, tired.
