NANNIE'S SWORD raced close up inside while in hand, angled out into the stretch, responded when roused and was along in time from the outside, driving. BARRISTER KATHLEEN stumbled badly at the start, was bumped after the start, rallied four wide and dug in gamely through the stretch. WHATA SMOOTHIE was taken back, raced inside, advanced nearing the stretch, came wide for the drive, altered course back to the inside in midstretch and finished gamely on the rail. MULTIPLE WINS was bumped at the start, argued the pace while between rivals and tired in the final furlong. PIANO CHIMES argued the pace while three wide and weakened in the stretch. LIVEITUPNOW set the pace and tired in the stretch.
