MEDALLIST came away well and sprinted out to a clear lead, set the pace along the inside, ran off to a long lead on the turn, settled into the stretch well in front and remained safely clear while being kept to the task to the wire. THE CLIFF'S EDGE was outrun early, rallied four wide on the turn and finished gamely outside. SIR SHACKLETON chased the pace while between rivals and stayed on well in the stretch. GOLDEN LOOK was unhurried early on, was hustled along on the rail on the turn but had no response and tired in the stretch. PREACHINATTHEBAR raced three wide and had no response when roused. SHANIKO chased the pace from the outside and tired.
