BITTEL ROAD away in good order, was soon on the lead, continued to show the way during the run around the bend, facing only token pressure from MUSCA, disposed of that rival after entering the lane, came into the furlong grounds with a sizeable advantage, then completed the final eighth under a vigorous hand ride, while being intermittently flashed the whip. CAIRIENE unhurried early, moved up on the turn after being asked for a bit more to reach a contending position, was fanned three wide at the head of the stretch, failed to advance any further, but still had plenty left to secure place honors. LIME RICKEY raced along the outside, advanced gradually toward the leaders when asked for a response on the turn, made a sharp left hand turn in upper stretch, got back into action under good handling, finishing willingly along the inside. MUSCA forwardly placed along the outside for a half, tired. SELLO never menaced. INVISIBLE STAR steadied after breaking sluggishly from the starting gate, was slow to find his best stride while racing greenly. GRAND MORNING was outrun.
