LOYAL SHADOW sat reserved during the run down the backstretch, moved out to the three path leaving the half mile pole, took off after being put to hand encouragement, zipping by rivals, lost none of the momentum turning for home, closed with powerful strides, collaring the leader a short distance before the finish line to prove best. FLYING SAPPHO was rated on an open lead towards the inside, scooted around the bend to enter the lane still maintaining a comfortable advantage, attempted to stave off the top one when that rival arrived on the scene, wasn't up to the task, relinquishing a few strides before the wire. Z CATS MEOW off a bit slowly, rushed into midpack along the hedge without needing to be asked for speed, was steadied after being rank approaching the turn, continue to loosely track the pacesetter, was taken to the middle of the course in upper stretch and displayed enough closing punch to be along for the show. MARKET COLLAPSE stalked the pacesetter for a half and tired. MISS DOLAN'S ROSE three wide, was put to a prolonged hard drive, failed to make any significant gain. JUSTINLINE taken hold early, folded. OUR MONTANA DREAM was never in the hunt.
