Footnotes

EAGER LEADER unhurried during the early stages, moved up to a good striking position leaving the half mile pole, remained well placed in the three path under a firm hold during the run around the bend, was strongly roused turning for home, battled a pair of rivals for the lead, poked a head in front a stride or two before the eighth pole, and edged clear. OCTOBER DREAMS sparred with FOOT THE BILL from the outside before shaking off that foe nearing the turn, swung towards the inside soon afterwards, continued to show the way, with a pair of rivals stalking just to the outside, came under assault from that duo entering the stretch, was set down, fought gallantly to protect the lead, reluctantly yielded midstretch, but continued on with good courage to take the place. JERICO RULES chased the leader from the outside while keeping something in reserve, was asked for run nearing the head of the stretch, was the middle member of a threesome vying for the lead during the run through the furlong grounds, held well before weakening in the final sixteenth. THUNDERING ROAR rode the hedge, slipped outward midpoint on the turn to clear a fading rival, lacked the necessary stretch response when called upon. SEVEN FIRSTS off slowly, stumbled right after the break, raced along the outside and failed to reach a contending position. FOOT THE BILL briefly disputed the pace along the inside before fading. CELESTIAL RIDGE broke a beat slowly and was always outrun.
