Footnotes

NORTH OCEAN was placed into the two path after the runner up tucked along the rail early down the backstretch, patiently prompted that opponent from the two path until nearing the quarter pole, was allowed to drift into the four path turning for home, imitating WILD PERFECTION moving outward at that station, got put to a strong hard drive, took over for good with an eighth to go and lengthened away. WILD PERFECTION edged away to a clear advantage and was guided over to the inside route prior to the initial split being recorded, showed the way facing pressure from the outside, was put to stronger and stronger encouragement making his way around the bend, left the three-eighths pole under a drive, drifted three wide into the stretch, with the top one following suit, surrendered the lead during the next furlong, held on well though for the place. AUGUST OSAGE underwent a three wide pursuit on the turn, proved no match. SHERTZER fell to his face at the break and was slow to settle into stride, departed the backstretch from the four path, swung even wider into the stretch, failed to menace. SONG OF ASPEN got outrun taking the overland route. CASH YOUR TICKET guided over to the rail at the five-sixteenths pole, was under a drive cutting the corner into the stretch, tired.
