PATH OF DREAMS saved ground in mid pack, came under encouragement getting angled out from the five-sixteenths to swing five wide in upper stretch, rallied with good energy into contention a sixteenth out, took command just inside that station and prevailed going away at the end. POSTER GIRL broke in at the start and was corrected before contact could be made, was well held early on into the first turn to settle just off the inside in mid pack, remained in hand until let out spinning three wide into upper stretch, rallied with good energy to secure the place honors in the last jumps. NEOLEXIA saved ground towards the rear, was steadied briefly off heels at the seven-eighths pole early on, came under urging at the three-eighths remaining inside, swung into the stretch just off the inside, kicked home belatedly to garner the show in the last jumps. TREASURED attended the pace from close range once settled down the backside from just off the inside, came under urging at the five-sixteenths to challenge for command, took a narrow lead at the head of the lane spinning just off the inside, dug in repulsing several challenges to the sixteenth pole when displaced by the eventual winner then was outfinished by a pair in the final jumps to the wire. ARRIBA ANNA three wide towards the rear initially, advanced quickly to mid pack following a similar spurt by GIANT'S JEWEL just prior, remained in hand until placed to urging three furlongs out, spun four wide into upper stretch, offered up a mild kick but was out kicked to the wire. PERFECT PACKAGE on the pace inside in hand spurting early on into the backside while a bit keen, settled as the field took closer order into the far turn, came under coaxing at the five-sixteenths under challenge for command, got roused cutting the corner into the stretch headed for the front, kept on to the eighth pole before weakening late on. GLENWOOD PINES two to three wide towards the rear, got placed to encouragement at the five-sixteenths, angled five wide into upper stretch and offered no response. MAGICAL WORLD tracked the pace along the inside within aim of the leader, came under urging at the five-sixteenths, cut the corner into the stretch and offered no rally. GIANT'S JEWEL three wide towards the rear initially, ranged up to be within range six furlongs from home, got spirited up three furlongs out, continued three wide into the stretch and tired in the late stages.
