BETTY'S HAT raced up inside, angled out and rallied three wide approaching the stretch, ran to the front without need of encouragement, drew away when asked and was ridden out to the finish. A LOT OF MARY pressed the pace from the outside, was no match for the winner and continued on to hold the place spot. SEMINOLE GAL was outrun early and lacked a rally. FAVORITE ENDING raced wide and tired. BEIJIO had no response when roused. RADIANCE (VEN) set the pace along the inside and tired in the stretch.
