NOBEL MITTERAND broke awkwardly, was bumped after the start, dropped back early, rallied inside on the turn, came wide into the stretch and finished gamely outside. FIAAFY had no rally. EVENING MIST had no response when roused. PENNANT DREAMS was bumped after the start, chased the pace along the inside and tired in the stretch. C. C. WILLIAMS chased the pace from the outside and tired in the stretch. APPEALING TRICK bore out on the turn and drifted out through the stretch.
