FOREVERNESS raced in hand early, advanced quickly after the opening half mile, drew clear into the stretch, took a clear lead into deep stretch then dug in and held on under a drive. DAVE was outrun early, came wide into the stretch and finished gamely outside. SABELLINA was outrun early, came wide for the drive and offered a mild rally outside. BANROCK had no rally. CLASSIC PACK raced inside and had no response when roused. RETRIBUTION ran off to a long lead and tired after the opening three quarters. BUILDING NEW ERA raced inside and tired.
