Footnotes

COOKRAM ROCK was unhurried early, rapidly gained on the turn, swung four wide while splitting horses at the quarter pole then prevailed after a long drive. CAMPTOWN BLUES waited along the inside on the turn, rallied along the rail in midstretch, checked and altered course to the outside at the sixteenth pole and rallied belatedly. WISE STOP was reserved early, rallied four wide at the quarter pole, dueled into midstretch and yielded late. LONG ISLAND LOUIE pressed the pace from outside, gained a slim lead at the quarter pole and weakened. N B RAVENS dueled along the rail for a half and tired. SMOOTH TRANSITION stumbled at the start with the rider coming out of the irons and was never close thereafter. ROBIN WOKE UP was outrun. JERICO RULES chased between horses and gave way at the quarter pole. There was a Stewards' Inquiry reviewing the start of the race before the result was declared official.
