BOOTS AHEAD pressed the pace between horses, shook loose in upper stretch then was fully extended to hold off the runner-up in the late stages. WELL SUITED was reserved early, swung five wide to launch his bid at the quarter pole and finished strongly in the middle of the track. STREET CRED was outrun after breaking slowly, saved ground on the turn then finished strongly along the rail. JOVE was outrun for a half, circled five wide entering the stretch and rallied belatedly. MR. SIZZLING pressed three wide into midstretch and faltered. CLOSE RANGE dueled along the rail into upper stretch and gave way. VAMEL saved ground to no avail. INTREPID pulled up in the early stages and was vanned off.
