RUSTLER HUSTLER off a beat slowly, underwent a four wide pursuit, took off in earnest when given his cue turning for home, grabbed the lead past the sixteenth pole despite weaving inward and outward in erratic fashion and edged away, crossing the wire under hand encouragement. NEW YAWKER chased three wide, ranged up to crank up the pressure shortly before going a half, entered the stretch and worked his way to a narrow advantage, held it until deep stretch, continued on with good energy to save second. COMMITMENT LETTER raced along the outside, was asked for a response in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths pole, remained a prominent factor before flattening out slightly in the final sixteenth. ALCOMATCH tracked the front runners from the rail, launched a bid from upper to midstretch, weakened in the late stages. SUN DANCE MOON three wide, had no response. KEY VICTORY kicked away to a clear lead with an alert start, showed the way from the two path, felt some pressure after going a half, gave way soon afterwards. MABOU darted over to the inside soon after the start, went on to save ground to no avail. D' SAUVAGE off the inside, was never in the hunt.
