MIA POPPY put to a snug hold leaving the starting gate, nonetheless looped all rivals breaking to his inside to take charge, showed the way, well rated from the inside and facing only token resistance, responded positively when asked for a response for the stretch drive, and held safely. AMPERSAND unhurried for the opening half, picked it up just a bit upon reaching the second turn, spun four wide into the stretch and got released from a firm hold on the reins, closed well belatedly to garner the place. MODERN CHILD saved ground throughout. HEAR THE FOOTSTEPS reserved in the two path for nearly a half, had no rally. WESTSIDE CORRAL swung five wide into upper stretch and lacked the needed response. GOOD PROSPECT undertook a tepid pursuit, got asked for a response at the five-sixteenths pole, backed away. FORTISSI MORE three wide around each bend, folded. ALLTIFFEDOFF took the inside route on the far turn to no avail.
