EMILY ALLSTAR was unhurried for the opening half while racing the outside, got put to encouragement coming to the end of the turn in preparation for the stretch run, fanned wide and settled into the four path, the widest of all, at the head of the stretch, picked up speed noticeably coming to the eighth pole, overtook the runner up with about seventy yards remaining and edged away, crossing the finish line under a hand ride. PROMISE ME A CAT kept a watchful eye on the pace dispute from the pocket, was taken outward and put three wide coming to the quarter pole, entered the stretch and was asked for a response, fought her way to a narrow advantage past the sixteenth pole, tried to stave off the winner but yielded when unable to keep pace. HEIR TO DARE dueled with DEVILISH SPIRIT soon after the start, cranked up the pressure nearing the end of the backstretch for a few strides, was allowed to drop back ever so slightly then turned up the heat for good coming to the five-sixteenths pole, had the battle spill over into the stretch, with the second place finisher lurking a danger just to the outside of the embattled front runners, continued on gamely until the vicinity of the sixteenth pole, got overtaken by the top pair but continued on with good energy to preserve the show award. DEVILISH SPIRIT argued for control from the inside until midstretch before backing away. POWHATAN PRINCESS well placed along the outside off the duel, had no response.
