**Footnotes**

LITTLE GABBY GIRL was bumped from both sides at the start, with the harder contact coming from LA BELLA CHABELLA, was quickly guided over to the rail, picked up interest prior to cutting the corner into the stretch, paused in hand for one jump as BLUE SIXTY FOUR was settling along the inside in the vicinity of the three-sixteenths pole, angled out sharply and immediately accelerated towards the last-mentioned rival, shot by and drew well clear thereafter. SHARPANDWITTY bumped at the start, moved up to dispute the pace with PRECIOUS FRANCA right afterwards, raced heads apart with that opponent during the run around the bend, was carried outward spinning into the lane and running through the furlong grounds as well, proved no match for the top one but held on well to secure second. PRECIOUS FRANCA bumped with the winner after stumbling at the start, got hooked up in a duel with the second place finisher just about from the get-go, sparred on even terms with that foe, kept at a slight distance from off the inside, drifted out at least path wide turning for home, drifted out even more shortly afterwards all the while taking the runner up along for a short ride each time, weakened late and had to settle for the show. BLUE SIXTY FOUR was the only member of the group of seven totally unscathed at the break, stalked the ongoing pace dispute, drafting behind its inner participant, ducked over to take advantage of sailing along the rail in upper stretch, made an abbreviated to momentarily hold the lead, yielded readily to the winner and gave out. CONCEALED made contact with PROUD SIREN a couple of jumps after the start, sat perched three wide off the duel, under a snug hold by the pilot for the majority of time doing so, came up empty. LA BELLA CHABELLA broke to the inside, was pulled away belatedly and made solid contact with the top one, was unhurried racing along the outside for the opening half, came three wide into the stretch, had no offering. PROUD SIREN bumped from between rivals at the start, raced off the inside while trailing throughout.
