NOTACATBUTALLAMA strung out three wide on the opening bend, stalked the pacesetter a bit closer to the rail on the subsequent one, ranged up to increase his presence approaching the quarter pole, continued to chisel away at the lead making his way through the furlong grounds, waited until almost at the eighth pole before being asked for his best, gave it, taking over the lead and edging clear. JOHA quickly established control, cut the pace, well rated from near the inside, felt the winner's intensified pressure leaving the five-sixteenths marker and got set down prior to spinning into the lane, yielded reluctantly, dug in stubbornly afterwards to preserve the place. BALANCE THE BOOKS contently rode the rail until halfway around the far turn, fanned four wide into the stretch with good momentum, maintained it after getting straightened away and charged home with a strong kick to take the show. NOBLE TUNE was taken in hand shortly after the start, was unhurried for nearly six furlongs, picked up the pace and swung three wide into the stretch, lacked a solid closing punch. NORTH SLOPE was grabbed hold after getting squeezed back a few strides after the start, raced from off the inside, placed between rivals during the run around the second bend, got called upon for the stretch, lacked the needed response. CHAMOIS taken back early, tracked the pacesetter sitting a loose pocket, faltered. FRONT stalked the pacesetter from the outside for over three-quarters and gave way.
