**Footnotes**

BOISTEROUS allowed to settle three wide in mid pack in a field strung out early on, took closer order as the field bunched into the far turn, came under urging at the five-sixteenths, angled four wide at the quarter pole, rallied to issue a challenge a furlong out and took narrow command at the eighth pole, edged clear under a drive to prevail. TWILIGHT ECLIPSE forwardly placed three wide under light coaxing, took closer order into the far turn, came under further urging three furlongs out, swung three wide for home, rallied to seize command nearing the eighth pole, led briefly until headed at that station, fought on to the wire unable to match strides with the aforementioned rival in the late stages while keeping on well for the place. EXCLUSIVE STRIKE rated just off the inside towards the rear, came under a ride at the five-sixteenths advancing into range, swung three wide at the quarter pole, offered up a mild belated kick to secure the show in the late stages. FINNEGANS WAKE broke a bit awkwardly at the start and got off half a beat slow, settled just off the inside towards the rear into the backside, remained patiently handled until three furlongs from home, got roused at that juncture, spun just off the inside into the stretch, offered up a mild kick to threaten briefly a furlong out then was outfinished in the late stages while safe for the last major share. OPTIMIZER broke out at the start bumping SPEAKING OF WHICH lightly at the break, was taken in hand and eased back to settle three wide in mid pack early on, took closer order nearing the far turn, shifted to the four path for the run around the bend, came under encouragement at the five-sixteenths, spun four wide for home unable to keep stride with the eventual winner who took the same path directly in front then weakened in the drive. AL KHALI saved ground towards the rear on hold until set down at the head of the stretch, got let out cornering just off the inside for home, offered no serious response. SPEAKING OF WHICH (IRE) in hand tracking the pace maker from closest range, angled out a path five furlongs out taking closer order on the front, took command midway on the turn as that foe retreated, remained in hand until spirited up at the head of the stretch, got headed straightened away and gave way. FOLK SINGER established the pace inside in hand spurting away early on through the first turn, remained on hold down the backside as the field took closer order into the far turn, came under coaxing nearing the three-eighths, got headed at that station, steadily retreated through the latter turn and tired.
