All entrants will be required to pay entry and starting fees. The added money and all fees to be divided 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% divided equally among remaining finishers. A trophy will be presented to the winning owner. The New York Racing Association reserves the right to transfer this race to the Main Track. In the event that this race is taken off the turf, it may be subject to downgrading upon review by the Graded Stakes Committee. Closed Saturday, June 30, 2007 with 32 Nominations and 1 Supplement. (If the Stewards consider it inadvisable to run this race on the turf course, this race will be run at One Mile on the main track.).

ART MASTER raced in hand along the inside early, came wide into the stretch, responded when set down and drew clear under a drive. WOODLANDER was outrun early, raced inside, rallied into the stretch and finished well on the rail. HOST (CHI) was outrun early, came wide for the drive and was going well late. JET PROPULSION was hustled out to a clear lead, set the pace along the inside and tired in the final furlong. YATE'S BLACK CAT chased the pace while three wide and tired in the stretch. CLASSIC CAMPAIGN raced close up along the inside, angled out into the stretch, had no response when roused and was vanned off after the finish. GIMME CREDIT raced in hand early, advanced on the turn, came wide into the stretch and came up empty when called on. LEADWITHYOURCHIN was outrun early, raced inside and had no response when roused. CARNERA chased the pace while between rivals and tired after the opening three quarters.
