DAWLY sat perched in the three path off an ongoing pace dispute, moved up to pressure the leader when the other early combatant backed away in the vicinity of the three-eighths pole, cranked up the pressure a furlong down the road, with the rider still attempting to keep something in reserve all the while, responded positively once given his cue, emerged from the furlong grounds the clear leader and edged away, kept under some encouragement to the end. SENSATIONAL SLAM raced along the outside and rallied for the place. TRUELEE SCRAPPIN stumbled in consecutive strides leaving the starting gate, moved up willingly shortly afterwards to contest the pace from the inside, fell back slightly near midpoint on the turn, held well thereafter to secure the show. DIVINE CHILD came four wide into upper stretch, made no serious bids. RAZMATAZ hounded throughout the opening half, gave way.
