JUDGE WELL was slow to settle into stride, picked up the pace towards the end of the backstretch, sat reserved off the inside near the back of the pack for nearly three-quarters, spun four wide into the stretch, had the rider release a firm hold on the reins after finishing the maneuver, gained readily during the furlong grounds, as almost the entire field converged at the eighth pole, split rivals coming to the sixteenth pole, grabbed away the advantage from PAVLOV'S DOG under a confident hand ride and edged away. PATENT PENDING TOM underwent a wide journey, lost a touch of ground and momentum forced to take the five path into the stretch for optimal racing clearance, displayed good energy down the outside of the course en route for place honors. PAVLOV'S DOG took the inside route, eagerly advanced towards the front runners once KRUGGERAND vacated the premises soon after entering the turn, paused briefly behind foes coming to quarter pole, wiggled off the inside turning for home and commenced to rally in earnest, moved between rivals to gain a slight advantage leaving the furlong grounds, was soon overhauled by the top one and weakened into the show slot. MEGALITHIC broke a short distance behind the rest of the competition after throwing his head just as the gate was sprung open striking the left side of the barrier as a result, raced at the rear for most of the early going, turned wide into the stretch, had advanced into a contending position during the run through the furlong grounds, when forced to check, entrapped behind a wall of opponents, idled for some time before finding an opportunity to swing outside, got put to energetic handling just past the sixteenth pole and flashed interest to earn the final major award. KUGGERAND looked to slip outward proceeding down the backstretch only to lack ample room to do so, was let out and opened up the needed ground leaving the half mile pole, bided time between rivals for the remainder of the run around the

bend, was asked for a response after entering the stretch, but failed to muster up the needed closing punch. N P CAT pressed a pair of foes for command from the three path and tired. ITOUCH contested the pace between foes, gave way. DUTYHONORCOUNTRY between rivals on the turn, folded. PALS FIRST LADY raced along the inside, disputed the pace from there with two others, got overwhelmed by midstretch and faded.
