NO FLAWS put to encouragement coming out of the starting gate, was taken in hand once LITTLE DALE established control, gave chase three wide on the turn, racing between opponents for a eighth of a mile from the five-sixteenths pole, continued onward, forged to the front during the final furlong and held sway, driving. B SHANNY tracked the leader while taking the inside route, was the innermost member of a threesome on nearly even terms from the five-sixteenths pole until upper stretch, resisted the rider's first attempt to angle outward, gave in the second time around, came home with good energy to procure the place. DOWN BROADWAY was hustled from the gate before settling into midpack, came four wide into the stretch and gained ground readily displayed long strides down the lane. HOWIE AND THE CAT broke last after lunging at the start, had the rider apply a strong grip on the left rein during the initial stages, was released from it early on the turn and acted professionally, advanced towards the front runners nestled between foes for a good portion of the run around the bend, initially was taken outward for the stretch drive, but after pulled hard left handed altered course back to the inside, finished willingly thereafter en route for the last major award. SILENT THUNDER raced along the outside, hesitating before successfully splitting rivals coming to the eighth pole, and went on to narrow the gap. LITTLE DALE off a sharp beginning, set the pace from the two path, succumbed to pressure leaving the eighth pole. FOX RULES was steadied after breaking outward, saved ground and failed to reach a contending position. RUTHERFORD B. three wide around the turn, had no rally. UNBRIDLED COMMAND between rivals, ducked inward in upper stretch, appeared to be already tiring when taken in hand after being nearly cut off by HOWIE AND THE CAT in the vicinity of the furlong marker. KHARAFa underwent a four wide pursuit and tired.
