Footnotes

POINT OF ENTRY well rated tracking the pace from the two path through easy fractions, ranged up under very little encouragement to engage the leader at the quarter pole, briefly sparred with that foe until shaking away nearing the furlong marker and drew clear through the final furlong kept to task to the line. CENTER DIVIDER marshaled the field through easy fractions while firmly held along the inside, came under coaxing for the initial time at the five-sixteenths when bracing for the aforementioned rival's challenge as the pressure intensified in behind, sparred briefly with that foe to just outside the furlong marker when displaced, kept on willingly to hold the place honors. TAHOE LAKE (BRZ) strongly held while tracking down along the hedge, was engaged by the rider at the three-eighths, steadily bid gaining ground to the wire to procure the show while being out kicked in the lane by the top pair. NEWSDAD between foes well held in the two path, was let out at the five-sixteenths, spun four wide for home, offered up a mild kick for the last major share. TREASURE BEACH (GB) three deep towards the rear in reserve, got spirited up at the five-sixteenths maneuvering four wide to unleash a rally, cornered five wide in upper stretch and offered no kick. HUDSON STEELE well rated three wide in midpack, was put to a drive at the three-eighths and tired in the lane. GAME BALL crossed to the inside shortly after the start, was the lone runner detached from the main body of the field early on, came under urging at the seven-sixteenths and trailed throughout.
