Footnotes

BROWN INDIAN grabbed a forward position soon after the start, had the rider sit chilly in the saddle from the two path within range for the opening half, got asked for a response entering the stretch and gave it, took charge during the later stages of the run through the furlong grounds and kicked clear under good handling. EL CORRIENTE disputed the pace from the outside, gained a slim advantage nearing the quarter pole, relinquished when unable to keep pace with the top one but finished willingly nonetheless to secure second. FEAR NOTHING angled outward in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths pole, was under a drive spinning four wide into the lane, lacked the needed response in the late stages en route for the show. LEROIDE SIOUX off the inside, had no

kick. VENTURA BAR took the inside route on the turn under some encouragement, made no impact. LUIGI P rode the rail in the early stages, was already under urging swinging three wide into upper stretch, showed some belated foot to improve position by weak and tired ones. COYOTE CANYON raced along the outside and was outrun. BAILEY PARK argued for control for nearly a half before giving way. BLUFF ROAD saved ground to no avail. PAVLOV'S DOG three wide on the turn, was through after going a half. HAYDENS HERO was never in the hunt. TOP YANK off a bit sluggishly, rushed up down the backstretch into a contending position, was four wide leaving the half mile pole, folded.
