**Footnotes**

BE BULLISH the only member of the field totally unscathed at the break, had DRIVEN BY SOLAR draw up directly abreast a few strides out of the starting gate, dueled on even terms with that opponent for a good portion of the way down the backstretch, had MARSH DAWG make it a three-way fight nearing the half mile pole, fell back slightly upon reaching that station, kept pace with the front runners, mildly hand urged to maintain interest, was given his cue and launched a rally along the clear sailing available on the inside route, took charge halfway through the furlong grounds, dug in with good determination to fend off the runner up's late challenge. DEHERE OF THE CAT was squeezed back after being bumped at the break, raced from off the inside, was under encouragement prior to spinning four wide into the stretch, came home with good energy en route for the place. JETER bumped at the start, advanced into a good stalking position after departing the backstretch, sat patiently parked out in the four path off the embattled pair for most of the run around the bend, ranged up and challenged them coming to the quarter pole, was allowed to drift in and get a good look at the top one in the vicinity of the three-sixteenths pole, got outfinished and had to settle for the show. COALTOWN LEGEND brushed with MARSH DAWG very shortly after the start, was three wide entering the turn and five wide exiting it, mustered up a mild stretch response to grab the last major check. DRIVEN BY SOLAR bumped at the start, shook off the contact and ranged up to hook up with the top one, went head to head with that foe for much of the initial quarter, had that nemesis replaced by MARSH DAWG approaching the end of the backstretch, sparred with the previously-named rival to the quarter pole, came under assault from two fresher rivals turning for home and soon succumbed. MARSH DAWG stumbled badly at the start, making light contact with COALTOWN LEGEND right afterwards, advanced with good speed and confronted the early duelers, had one of them, that being the winner, drop out of the dispute in short order, sparred with DRIVEN BY SOLAR thereafter around the turn, doing so from the three path, was still in battle but from between rivals heading home, begin to back away about a sixteenth later.
