Footnotes

MY JOPIA contently stalked the pacesetter from near the two path, at times loosely drafting behind FIVE STAR MOMMA while racing around the bend, altered course to the outside and got asked for run immediately after having done so, kicked into her best stride and closed in rapidly on the leader, collared that one with about a sixteenth to go, then showed good determination in the late stages to stave off the second place finisher. SWEET AND LOVELY gave chase from the outside, was asked for a response entering the stretch, was guided over closer to the rail as the winner was altering course in the opposite direction, finished with good energy but couldn't get there in time. BALLISTIC SUE was quickly in front and quickly tucked along the rail, cut the pace, being rated and facing no real resistance, felt some pressure for the initial time soon after entering the lane and was asked for run in response, had the lead snatched away in the vicinity of the sixteenth pole, weakened steadily thereafter into the show slot. FIVE STAR MOMMA came inward and bumped with the nearest opponent at the start, went on to assume the role of primary pursuer, chased the pacesetter from the two path, was set down by the five-sixteenths pole, backed away steadily soon afterwards. ROMAN INVADER bumped from both sides at the start, raced from off the rail, failed to reach a contending position. VINDA three wide, had no rally. NO SATIS ACTION broke to the outside, had the rider attempt to pull away from ROMAN INVADER but made contact with that rival nevertheless, took the inside route, appeared done by the quarter pole and entered the lane under a protective hold, got eased, then pulled up past the eighth pole and was subsequently vanned off.
