Footnotes

SUN STORM leaned upon by an errant ONE MORE CHIEF, got carried inward by that foe before shying in slightly more under his own initiative, was placed on a truer course in short order and put to some hand urging, steadily advanced down the backstretch into a forward position, remained under constant hand encouragement on turn, except for a respite consisting of several strides between the five-sixteenths marker and the quarter pole, was given his cue once more and responding positively, angled three wide into the lane, brushing with SALTINE WARRIOR while doing so, was put to a hard drive and would remain under it the rest of the way to the wire, came out a path or so with a sixteenth to go, taking SALTINE WARRIOR along for a very short ride, forged on ahead and got up about three jumps prior to the wire. THNXTOMYUNCLE saved ground to the five-sixteenths pole, was asked for run and angled outward four wide into the stretch, got straightened away with no loss of momentum and came home with good energy to procure the place. ONE MORE CHIEF broke inward, making light contact with the winner and forcing that rival to move towards the rail as well, got placed to some hand urging and secured the lead, tucked along the rail, showed the way being pressed along by a rated HORATIO, arrived at the eighth pole on nearly terms with that foe and got set down, remained in a spirited tussle with the same rival even as the top two went by in the late stages and gamely grabbed the show. HORATIO prompted ONE MORE CHIEF, patiently handled for almost a half, was turned loose entering the stretch, raced heads apart with ONE MORE CHIEF the entire way down the lane and got outfinished. HOOKED FOREVER off the inside, rallied mildly. SALTINE WARRIOR taken back after being involved early with the pace, underwent a three wide pursuit, got asked for a response leaving the five-sixteenths pole, made light contact with the top one entering the stretch, kept pace with that opponent to the sixteenth pole, got taken in hand when herded out a bit then weakened in the late stages. SUN WORSHIPPER rode the rail to upper stretch, was swung into the four wide path between the three-sixteenths pole and furlong marker, came up empty after finishing the maneuver. SIR MAURICE raced along the outside and trailed.
