SOUTHERN IVY raced close up inside, dug in gamely in the stretch and was driving under the wire. EDEN LODGE contested the pace from the inside and stayed on gamely to the finish. OFFTHETURF raced close up early, came wide into the stretch and finished gamely outside. BROWN EYED LASS contested the pace while four wide and stayed on well to the finish. WITCHFUL SAINT put in a five wide run on the turn and weakened in the final furlong. DUSTY'S SECRET chased the pace while three wide and tired. COLONIAL BALL had no response when roused. TALENT TO THE MAX tired badly and was eased in the stretch.
