

PERFECT STING was unhurried early on, advanced outside on the second turn, dug in determinedly outside in the stretch and got up late after a prolonged drive. SNOW POLINA quickly showed in front, set the pace, took a clear lead past the eighth pole and stayed on gamely but could not resist the winner. PICO TENERIFFE raced close up inside while in hand, saved ground and stayed on well to the finish. INNUENDO (IRE) was rated outside, raced four wide on both turns and lacked a solid finishing kick. COLSTAR chased the pace along the inside and tired in the stretch. EMANATING was rated along early, put in a four wide run on the second turn and had nothing left for the drive. SPANISH FERN broke awkwardly, raced inside and had no response when roused. LA VILLE ROUGE chased the pace while three wide and tired in the stretch.
