Footnotes

BANKING HOLIDAY was well placed along the rail for a half, angled out at the quarter pole, surged to the front inside the furlong marker and edged clear under left hand urging. CHIEF EXPORT set the pace along the rail into midstretch and yielded late while clearly second best. SMOOTH WIND saved ground for a half, waited on the turn and closed late along the inside to gain a share. ALL IN NO OUTS was outrun for a half after breaking slowly and rallied belatedly between horses. GERONI steadied between horses on the turn, split horses while five wide at the quarter pole and flattened out late. MOUNT WILTON failed to threaten while racing wide. FREGATA pressed the pace between horses for a half and gave way. JAPENGO chased the leaders from outside, drifted six wide at the quarter pole and tired. PARK AVENUE PRINCE was never a factor.
