**Footnotes**

MOR CHANCES chased the pacesetter from the two path, while keeping something in reserve, moved in company with SIX FLINGS perched outside approaching the five-sixteenths pole en route to wresting command away from BRAZEN KAT, engaged in stretch duel with SIX FLINGS, turned back that rival to preserve the decision. HOT MONEY underwent a wide journey and came home with good courage to garner place honors. SIX FLINGS three wide, tagged along with the winner en route to the front nearing the five-sixteenths pole, battled on nearly terms with the top one during the stretch drive, before flattening out a bit in the late stages. EXTRA ZIP took the inside route, angled outward at the quarter pole before commencing to rally, took off in earnest, gained readily during the run through the furlong grounds, maintained the momentum and continued to close ground during the final sixteenth while primarily under his own power. GOLD VENDETTA between rivals on the turn, lacked the needed bid. LOVE ABROAD was no factor. BRAZEN KAT cut the pace towards the inside, offered little resistance when challenged by a pair of rivals and steadily tired thereafter. CHERNOBYL'S HERO saved ground to no avail. GOLD BEAR underwent a wide journey and tired.
