THEDA'S SMILE away in good order sat well reserved in midpack in the two path for the opening mile, was placed four wide at the head of the stretch before commencing to rally in earnest, closed in willingly departing the furlong grounds, joined up with the battling front runners with about a sixteenth to go and got her nose down in time at the wire to prevail. SENADA broke awkwardly, was grabbed hold and put back on course, lumbered towards the inside, settling along the rail well before reaching the opening bend, was content to lag behind, under a firm hold, was given up some rein and had her interest perked up late on the far turn, moved up to be a more serious contender, scooting by opponents by cutting the corner into the stretch, angled outward, making it into the two path but no further, being prevented to do so by MORNINGSIDEHEIGHTS, drove through an open gap between rivals just prior to the eighth pole en route to grabbing a narrow lead, dug in well, but got nipped at the finish line. MISS LAA DI DA (GB) was rated prompted the pacesetter from the outside for the initial six furlongs, was asked to pick up the pace nearing the five-sixteenths pole, bid between rivals from that station to the wire, held a clear advantage at the eighth pole, only to have it snatched by the runner up before going an additional sixteenth down the road, held well for the show thereafter. PROUD LISA three wide around both turns, lacked the necessary stretch response. MORNINGSIDEHEIGHTS saved ground to no avail. DANCIN PERFECT underwent a three wide journey, made no bids. ALL ABOUT ALEX rated inside until the quarter pole, faltered.
