**Footnotes**

MARBLEHEAD HARBOR underwent a three wide pursuit, ranged up into a good striking position departing the backstretch, making her way past weakening rivals, issued a challenge by the end of the turn, left the furlong grounds, holding a clear advantage and edged away, driving. MISS MEXIQUE rode the pocket until the quarter pole, rallied for the place. VINTAGE HEIRLOOM raced along the outside, split rivals coming to the sixteenth pole, got up for the show. STELLA DI SICILIA set the pace from the inside and gave way. UNKNOWN WONDER was hustled from the gate into a forward position, vacated the rail leaving the backstretch, was given her cue and took off with a four wide sweep, flattened out during the final furlong. BORO KID three wide, lacked the needed response. EMERALD CITY GIRL off the inside, failed to reach contention. CANTSTOPLOVSUE ducked inward at the start, left the elbow chute five wide and offering fierce resistance to the riding tactics being applied by the jockey, rushed up the widest of all down the backstretch, tucked into the two path after circling her way past all but one opponent, attended the pace until the five-sixteenths pole, had little to offer at that station and tired. MORGANE'S PRINCESS had a four wide journey and was outrun. POETIC TOUCH offered little.
