Footnotes

PERFECT EMBRACE set the pace under light urging and prompted from along the inside, was let out at the head of the lane, edged away under a drive to score safely kept bust to the end. SASTA GO LUCKY broke out at the start and was corrected, was in pursuit three to four wide through the turn, commenced a bid on the front from the five-sixteenths while three wide, proved unable to reel in the top one through the stretch while keeping on for place honors safe. SANTORINI MOON tracked the pace from the inside, was pushed along from the three-eighths pole, cut the corner into the lane, shifted out near the three-sixteenths bumping a tiring foe at that juncture, bid mildly through the lane for the show honors. SOCIAL STATEMENT prompted the pace from the two path, was placed to a drive at the three-eighths, was weakening when bumped as SANTORINI MOON shifted out at the three-sixteenths, continued to weaken thereafter. FIRST PENNY just off the pace from the two path, was coaxed along from the five-sixteenths, swung three wide for home and offered no kick. PELAGO chased three wide coming under encouragement at the five-sixteenths, spun four wide in upper stretch and offered no response. MILL BRANCH MILLIE squeezed back lightly at the start, came under hustling in response, took the overland route through the turn while trailing.
