MONARCH'S MAZE, wrapped in the early going, split rivals in deep stretch and finished with a rush to get up on the line. GRITTY SANDIE, outrun early, raced inside, came wide for the drive and finished gamely from the outside. DISCOVERY RIDGE raced close up outside while in hand, rallied wide on the second turn and stayed on gamely while between rivals in the stretch. GRIGRI, close up inside early, split rivals in midstretch, earned a short lead inside the eighth pole and stayed on well to the finish. ISLAND SUNSET prompted the pace from the outside while in hand, earned a short lead in midstretch and gave ground grudgingly in the final furlong. ANTITRUST, rated along outside, raced wide throughout and lacked a solid finishing kick. ADEPT had no response when roused. STASH quickly showed in front, set the pace into the stretch and gave way. POOR PORGY, steadied entering the first turn, raced wide and tired.
