### Footnotes

BROTHER KEITH bobbed slightly at the start, settled between horses, swung five wide to launch his move entering the stretch and closed steadily to wear down MIKE FROM QUEENS in the late stages. MIKE FROM QUEENS pressed three wide to the top of the stretch, opened a clear advantage in midstretch and yielded grudgingly. WOLFSON raced in hand while saving ground, was behind a wall of horses entering the stretch, angled out to get clear in upper stretch and finished willingly. TODD GOT EVEN dueled between horses for five furlongs and weakened. THE TRUFFLE MAN dueled along the rail into upper stretch and tired. RODMAN stalked four wide to the top of the stretch and gave way.
