SARAFINA patiently stalked the leader three wide down the backstretch, moved up to increase the pressure departing the backstretch, had SONG FOR PUPCAKE make it a threesome after that one advanced from the two path to join the front runners, continued to vie for the lead under her own power for the rest of the way on the turn, was let out turning for home, displayed a sudden spurt of speed to take over and open up a quick two lengths on the rest of the field a short distance from the eighth pole, maintained a safe margin under brisk encouragement to the end. MARIE'S BABE raced between rivals for a good portion of the run around the bend, traded several light bumps with DONNA'S DANDEE stubbornly refusing to allow the aforementioned rival to bully her out of the two path entering the stretch, responded well when given her cue, displaying good energy to garner place honors. GRANDMA underwent a three wide journey, bided time behind rivals as the field headed for the top of the stretch, was tipped outward a bit at the eighth pole and rallied willingly thereafter to grab the show. SONG FOR PUPCAKE sat forwardly placed throughout, bid between rivals from the seven-sixteenths pole to the five-sixteenths pole, before going one on one with the eventual winner, backed away when unable to match the top one's burst of energy nearing the eighth pole, weakened steadily thereafter. HOOKIN THE GOODS, fell back slightly after being taken in hand just after the break, was placed four wide for the stretch run, lacked the needed response. DONNA'S SANDEE raced towards the inside for nearly three-quarters, tried to angle outward in the vicinity of the quarter pole, exchanged several bumps with runner up during the attempt, was denied. HEARTED stumbled at the start, set the early splits while taking the inside route, was put to the test by one, then another in the vicinity of the seven-sixteenths pole, succumbed late on the turn.
