PEACE NOW off to an alert beginning, was successfully eased back off the front runner, stalked the leader, three wide and being coaxed along to keep pace, continued along on the same scenario until the quarter pole, took off in earnest after entering the stretch, struck the front at the eighth pole, went out several paths from a solitary left handed shot, continued onward under hand encouragement, acted more professionally when feeling the whip from the left side the second time, edged away, crossing the wire under a brisk hand ride. MR. STARR'S REPORT grabbed the front soon after leaving the gate, showed the way from the rail, feeling some pressure and with the eventual winner lurking in the three path in close proximity, was put to the test heading into the stretch, offered good resistance before yielding to the top one's challenge with about a furlong remaining, continued on willingly to secure the place. WRITETHATDOWN within range three wide, paused coming to the quarter pole, was placed in the four path at the top of the lane, got out finished. FOGGY MAX between rivals for a good portion of the run around the bend, lacked the necessary stretch response. GOLDEN TORNADO broke slowly, began the stretch drive five wide, had no rally. CITY WHISPER failed to menace. UNCLE JOE underwent a four wide pursuit and tired. PAPA FREUD pressed the pace between rivals from the seven-sixteenths pole to the quarter pole before backing away. OUR CORN saved ground, was urged on the turn, but made no gain.
