RIGHT ONE (FR) was taken back after the start, sat reserved along the outside, was given some rein late on the turn and began to pick up interest, turned for home in the four path, was put to much stronger handling after being straightened away, gained readily on the front runners making his way through the furlong grounds, continued onward with good courage, finally nailing YIELD BOGEY in the last jump to prevail. YIELD BOGEY away in good order, grabbed command quickly, showed the way in the middle of the course during the early stages, was gradually angled over to the inside, tucking along the rail about midpoint on the backstretch, sailed along, rated under a firm hold and virtually uncontested, was let out coming to the three-sixteenths pole as the pressure from the closest pursuers intensified, defiantly emerged from the furlong grounds unscathed, dug in with gaminess as the top one made his presence felt by deep stretch, got nipped right at the finish line. EVOLUTIONIST a forward factor right from the get-go, was rated near the three path until the quarter pole, got called upon spinning into the stretch, and got outfinished. RADIOHEAD (GB) sat reserved from off the inside, slipped into the three path midway on the turn, briefly drafted behind EVOLUTIONIST, was already under encouragement turning for home, made no headway on the front runners. GANTRY patiently stalked the pacesetter from the outside, was put to strong encouragement leaving the three-eighths pole, ducked inward entering the stretch, weakened steadily during the stretch run. TARGHEE PASS lagged behind for nearly a half, swung five wide into the stretch, was no menace. NORDIC TRUCE saved ground until the three-sixteenths pole and tired.
