PRECURSOR raced three wide and finished with good courage to be garner place honors. WESTERN LEGEND saved ground throughout and finished well to take the show. D C TAPIT was slow to settle into stride while racing greenly, flashed some late interest during the stretch drive. KEEPING THE HONOR lunged at the start, was never a factor. PRINCE CHARMING raced along the inside, lacked the necessary bid during the final eighth. NINTH CLIENT urged early, was never a threat. AUDIBLE was never involved. SOLUTIONIST hustled from the starting, pressed the pace from the three path for a half and gave way. MIKE FROM QUEENS vied for the lead between rivals and faltered after turning for home.
