SHE'S GOT RULES settled into midpack soon after the start, stalked the front runners from the outside under a snug hold until midpoint on the turn, ranged up to the front willingly from that point, made a successful challenge for command, three wide and between rivals coming to the quarter pole, but with the runner up only head or so behind and bearing down hard in the middle of a challenge of her own, responded positively once given her cue, drifted in ever slightly then kicked clear during the ensuing furlong, held sway, kept to a drive to the end. NORTHERN WARRIOR rode the rail, made a run at the leader from the inside as the winner while making a three wide challenge, went by FIDDLES DIVA in unison with the top one late on the turn, entered the stretch only a head shy of the front, began to fall back as the two front runners proceeded along their way through the furlong grounds, altered course rather than venture through a tight rail opening approaching the eighth pole, proved no match after completing the maneuver but was well clear of the others for the place. KAFFIEND accompanied the pacesetter from the outside, albeit from a distance, for nearly a half, weakened steadily thereafter. HIT YOUR STRIDE bumped lightly at the start, was no factor. THERE GOES MOLLY made light contact with HIT YOUR STRIDE leaving the starting gate, was asked early but failed to improve position down the backstretch, angled into the three path soon after entering the turn, was put to a prolonged drive but failed to have an impact on the outcome. TOO TOUGH SISSY four wide at the half mile pole, tired. BELLA LADY three wide departing the backstretch, folded. FIDDLERS DIVA bobbled at the start, but being so full of run, grabbed the lead nonetheless and sped off under her own power, entered the turn slightly off the inside, but was well in the two path nearing the end of it, came under pressure from the both the right and left sides just prior to the quarter pole and got overwhelmed.
