IRISH PRINCESS raced close up inside, rallied three wide approaching the stretch and dug in gamely along the inside in the drive. FLYING PICKLE was rated along early, came wide into the stretch and lacked a rally. ROCKIN RACHEL ANNE stumbled at the start, raced with the pace while in hand and tired in the stretch. DANCETHEBLUESAWAY raced inside and had no rally. SARATOGARMANALEG had no response when roused. I. B. HANSIE chased the pace while three wide and tired. RUSHING FORCE was outrun. RAPIDO TOO set the pace along the inside and tired. J RO was steadied at the start and tired.
