FEROCIOUS WON allowed to settle into stride while racing along the outside, moved when ready three wide approaching the top of the stretch, ranged up to the leader confidently handled, took over leaving the eighth pole then extended his advantage under a vigorous hand ride. MASS CHARLES away from the starting gate, showed the way on an uncontested lead, squandered that advantage by midstretch, but had enough left to protect the place. READY READ was along for the show. REMORSE chased the pacesetter, lacked a rally. HALO'S TIGER was no menace. SUPER ENVOY was never in contention. INTIMIDATING displayed brief foot. SUNY'S BOY steadily tired after racing a quarter. KILN CREEK offered little.
