**Footnotes**

RUBY'S TUNE was in hand early, raced far back for six furlongs, circled six wide at he quarter pole then closed strongly in the middle of the track to get up in the final twenty yards. A. P. LIGHT trailed for a half, made a strong five wide move to reach contention on the turn, charged to the front in midstretch but couldn't withstand the winner's late charge. MUSICAL SPLENDOR saved ground in good position to the turn, came around horses in midstretch then finished well while splitting rivals in the late stages. SMALL POTATOES was under a firm hold along the rail, steadied in tight at the half mile pole, stayed in on the turn, then lacked clear running room for a good portion of the stretch run. HIER ENCORE raced well back for six furlongs, was in traffic between horses on the turn, angled out and lacked a late response. WISE CHOICE raced up close three wide to the turn, gained a slim lead in upper stretch then checked while tiring along the inside in deep stretch. KITTYS WISH was outrun for six furlongs, circled seven wide and lacked a late response. HELLO GOLD set the pace inside and tired in midstretch. GRAPHITE HALO pressed the pace in the two path and gave way on the turn. There was a Stewards' Inquiry into the stretch run before the result was declared official.
