COURAGEOUS CAT was in hand along the inside, moved up between horses to challenge after going a half, opened a clear advantage in upper stretch, dug in when threatened in deep stretch and prevailed under steady urging. AL KHALI was rated on the rail for a half, checked along the inside on the far turn, swung three wide nearing the quarter pole and closed late from outside but could not get up. MIKOSHI was well placed for a half, lodged an outside move to threaten on the turn then weakened in midstretch. HELLO BROADWAY steadied in traffic soon after the start, was under a firm hold to the turn then lacked the needed response when called upon. ANAAN set the pace along the rail to the far turn and gave way.
