RETROACTIVE raced close up inside, got through on the rail approaching the stretch, drew clear when roused and remained well clear under a drive. NOBEL MITTERAND ducked in at the start, was outrun early, came wide into the stretch and finished well outside. LUMINANCE contested the pace while three wide and tire in the final furlong. VEILED THREAT had no rally. WARM FEELINGS raced four wide and tired. BON LIL drifted out badly in the stretch.
