CAT NIPPER showed good speed along the inside, drew away in the stretch and was ridden out to the finish. RUSSIAN REED raced inside and stayed on to be second best. INKABANNER raced between rivals and tired. POET'S LADY was steadied at the start and had no rally. COMEDY OF ERRORS broke awkwardly and raced inside. DOCTOR MUSIC tired after three quarters. CANDY CANE (ARG) raced four wide and tired. KATUNA TERMS tired after showing brief speed. WHARF N' LADY was outrun.
